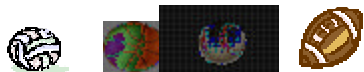


SPORTS BANQUET DATE CHANGE

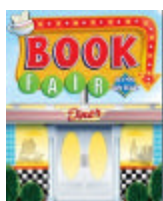


Vacation Bible School 2010
